MSS PUBLISHES THREE NEW STANDARDS

Vienna, VA – The Manufacturers Standardization Society (MSS) is pleased to announce the following three new publications:

- **MSS SP-140-2012, *Quality Standard Practice for Preparation of Valves and Fittings for Silicone-Free Service***
Summary: This Standard Practice establishes general requirements for valves and fittings for use in silicone-free service requiring an increased level of cleanliness. Specific requirements include: Cleaning, Assembly and Testing of Valves, Inspection and Acceptance, Packaging, and Marking. This Standard Practice is intended for applications such as painting systems which are sensitive to silicone contamination and for other services requiring an increased level of cleanliness above that of standard industrial valves. - **MSS SP-141-2012, *Multi-Turn and Check Valve Modifications***
Summary: This Standard Practice establishes minimum requirements for the modification of new gate, globe, and check valves, which have been manufactured in accordance with recognized national standards, and require modification to meet specific end-user requirements. The purpose of this Standard Practice is to ensure that the quality of workmanship and materials meet all applicable standards and codes. The procedures contained within this Standard Practice are general in nature and the facility performing the modification(s) may need to augment them as necessary to achieve compliance with all applicable codes and standards. List Price: \$116.00 per copy.
- **MSS SP-142-2012, *Excess Flow Valves for Fuel Gas Service, NPS 1½ through 12***
Summary: This Standard Practice covers Excess Flow Valves of pipe size NPS 1½ through 12, designed for use in fuel gas piping systems to reduce the flow of gas should the flow in the system exceed some predetermined level.
List Price: \$83.00 per copy.
